

We are very happy to be welcoming you back to Adult Learning Lewisham's centres at the start of a new academic year. Please read on for the steps we are taking to keep learners and staff safe





- The government still recommends all learners and staff attending education centres take lateral flow covid tests before coming in
- The easiest option is to take a test at home, preferably on the day you are attending but the day before is OK too
- You can access tests using these links
 Order lateral flow tests to be sent to your home
 Find the nearest place where you can collect lateral flow tests
- We may be able to help if you have problems getting a test kit. Ask the centre reception for more information





- If you receive a positive test it is VITALLY important you let Adult Learning Lewisham know
- Please call 020 8314 3300 and be prepared to tell us
 - Your name
 - Subject(s) you are studying with course codes if known
 - Name of tutor
 - Centre and dates and times of the last lesson(s) you attended
 - Anyone at Adult Learning Lewisham you had face to face contact with for more than 15 minutes who is not in your class.
- Remember If you get a positive lateral flow test you will also need to book a PCR test <u>Book test here</u> or by calling 119

Staying safe – How long do I need to isolate?



- You must isolate for 10 days if:
 - You test positive for Covid-19 or start showing symptoms whether or not you are vaccinated
 - are an adult who has not been fully vaccinated, and you are identified by contact tracers as a close contact of someone who has tested positive
 - are an adult who lives with someone who tests positive (or has Covid symptoms) and you are not fully vaccinated
- You do not need to isolate if you have been fully vaccinated and the second dose was at least two weeks before your contact with someone who has tested positive
- If you have symptoms please do not return to Adult Learning Lewisham until you feel well enough even if it takes longer than 10 days.
- Check that your class is continuing by phoning 020 8314 3300 before you return.

Staying safe – Attending class – What has changed?



- Social distancing is no longer required so classroom numbers will return to pre-pandemic levels.
- In line with Government guidance mask wearing in class or whilst moving around inside the centres is no longer compulsory. Of course you may continue to wear a face covering if you prefer.
- We will still need to work together to minimise our risk.



Staying safe – Attending class – What measures remain in place for our safety?



- Perspex screens at receptions
- One way systems and keep left signs
- Hand sanitizer stations and posters reminding us to wash hands frequently
- An extra daily clean of touch points in the centres
- Opening windows in classrooms and offices
- A requirement to clean work areas and equipment before and after use

Going to your classroom


 Where the building layout allows we have made corridors and stairs one way – arrows on the floor and wall signs will direct you

- We strongly encourage you to bring in your own smart phone or tablet to use in the classroom if needed. Remember the wi-fi at ALL is freely available
- If you are issued with a laptop or tablet for classroom use please clean them before and after with the sanitiser we provide



The facilities

- All toilets will be fully open
- Clean hands remain very important to protect against the virus. Please use the sanitizer stations around the centres if you do not have access to soap and water

- Our cafes will be open as usual from 13 September
- Café seating is restored to prepandemic levels
- Where possible we still encourage you to take your food and drink to outside tables if weather allows

 There is no longer a requirement to leave the centres by a particular route. You may use the same door to enter and exit
